What kind of transportation is provided to the students to access the clinics/services that are not on site?

- Unfortunately, we do not have resources to provide transportation to the LAUSD run clinics. The clinics that partner with us may provide transportation services. However, on occasion, the school's Healthy Start Navigators can provide bus tokens if needed.

Are these medical services only available to K-12 LAUSD students?

- At the LAUSD staffed clinics- we see K-12 and younger siblings. At the clinics run by partners- they will see community members- all family members.

What is the wait time so schedule an appointment?

- Most sites take walk ins, however it is recommended that an appointment be made. Often times we offer same day appointments.

Is there anyone we can reach out to for scholarships?

- Scholarships are handled at the school level and the best source of information would be the school counselor.
