- [How is SIJS verified?](#)
The child needs to be under the custody of the court or guardian. You would need to go to probate court and apply for a petition with USDIS. This is not specific to unaccompanied minors. It is open to anyone who meets the requirements.

- [Is there a waiting list for services offered by IILA?](#)
It ebbs and flows and often depends on the service. If we are not able to take the case immediately, we can provide a timeline or offer a list of other providers.
- [Are services offered only to unaccompanied minors or adult clients as well?](#)
Services are available to all undocumented individuals not just unaccompanied youth.
- [When do you recommend clients apply to get assistance for DACA through IILA?](#)
With regard to renewing DACA, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services ("USCIS") recommends that you submit your DACA renewal application 120 to 150 days before the date your current DACA and EAD expire. Also, DACA recipients are not able to renew their DACA if they do not re-apply within one year of the date their current DACA expired. If an individual is not sure about when to renew, they can contact us and we can help them figure out when they should apply.
