Questions:

What strategies help to sustain youth engagement and empowerment as youth transition through their lives and may shift to other areas or experience?

- Warm handoffs and having good relationships with partners and programs to help youth with those key transitions. It is important to help youth build meaningful and lasting adult relationships and connections that last. The Alliance specifically has a TAY program that helps young adults with supportive services and connections to resources.

How do you keep moving the work forward and ensure that people in positions of power buy in?

- It is important for leaders to build structures that allow staff to be intentional about their work. This then works its way down to how youth are treated within the system and program.
